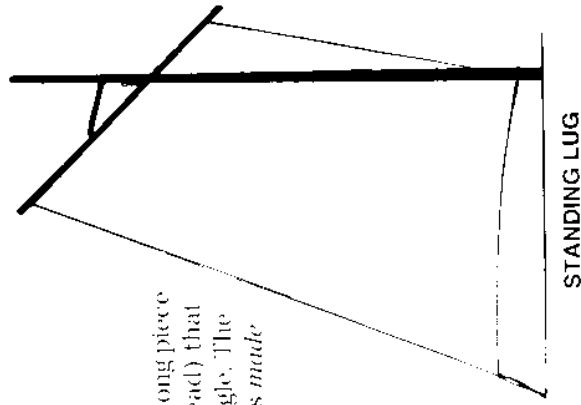
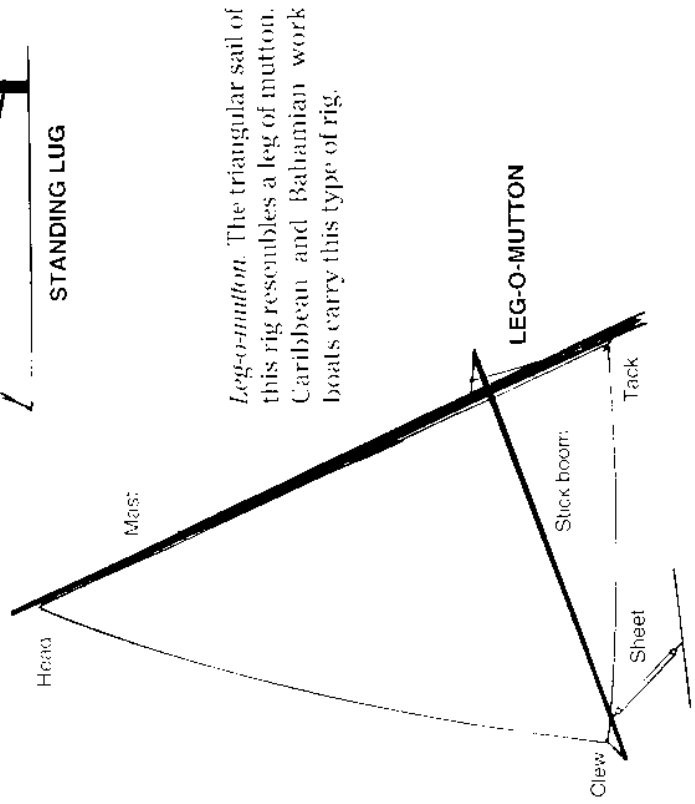


Parts of Rigging



Standing lug. This rig has a *yard* (a long piece of timber on which a sail is spread) that crosses the mast at an oblique angle. The forward lower corner of the sail is *made fast* to the mast.



Leg-o-mutton. The triangular sail of this rig resembles a leg of mutton. Caribbean and Bahamian work boats carry this type of rig.
